| colonisation | The action or process of settling among and establishing control over the indigenous people of an area |

| empire | A number of individual nations that are all controlled by the government or ruler of one particular country |
| export | Sending goods out of a country to be traded with other people or countries |
| import | Bringing goods into a country as a trade from other people or countries |
| merchant | A person or company that trades (buys and sells) goods |
| Oba | The title for the ruler of Benin – it is their word for king |
| trade | Exchanging goods or money between different people and countries |
