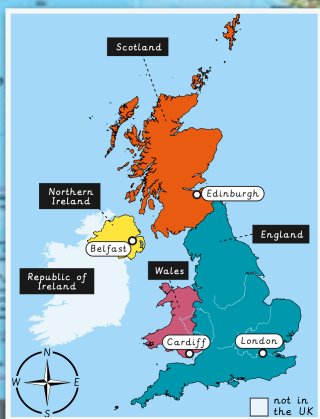
Key learning
