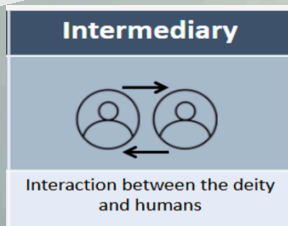


Who are the creator's intermediaries?

Creation Vocabulary

Intermediary	Special people that are trusted to share the creator's message
Incarnation	God in human form
Saviour	Someone who rescues people from something bad, sad or dangerous
Advent	Means 'coming'. The 4-week lead up to Christmas

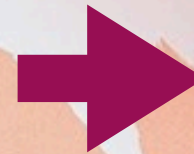
Prior Knowledge:

- Intermediary's are special people that the creator entrusted to share their knowledge.
- Angel Gabriel told Mary she was going to have a baby who was God's son, called Jesus.
- Jesus is the incarnation of God. He was born in a stable in Bethlehem, visited by shepherds & kings.
- Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus.
- Abraham is the Father of the Jews. He was the first Jew.
- God spoke through Abraham and - - Abraham told people about God.
- God promised to look after Abraham's family.
- All Jews are related to Abraham.
- Jews are God's people



Key Knowledge:

- I will know that some Jews believe...
- God will send a saviour
 - The saviour will restore their relationship with God
 - God will come to Earth at some point
- I will know that some Christians believe...
- Advent is a time for focusing on the arrival of Jesus.
 - Jesus had a lowly birth
 - Jesus's lowly birth shows that all people are precious and special to God
 - Jesus's is the incarnation of God



Generalisation:

- A Saviour rescues
- A Saviour restores relationships
- Advent is a time of waiting and preparation for the birth of Jesus
- Jesus was the son of God
- The Shepherds and King visitors reflect Jesus' importance as a saviour.
- Incarnation means 'God in human form'
