Tefillah: The Hebrew word for prayer

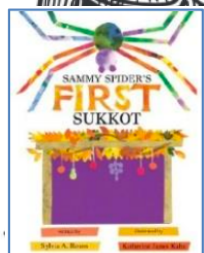
Thankful: to be happy or grateful for something happening.
