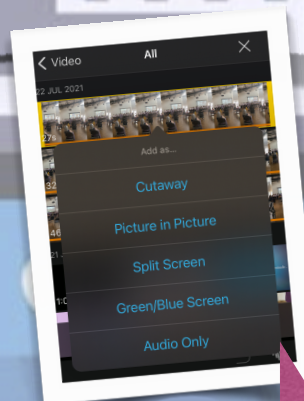

Key vocabulary

cutaway	Adding two video clips and using the video from one and the audio from another
getach audio	Removing the audio from a video clip
green / blue screen	A way of changing the background of a video clip to make it look like it was filmed somewhere else
Ken Burns effect	An effect on a photo in a movie that makes the camera appear to zoom in and out of it
picture in Picture	Having one video clip playing in a smaller version in front of another one
split	To cut a video clip into two separate parts and create two separate clips
split screen	Having two video clips playing at the same time, using half of the screen each
titles	Text you can add to a movie
trimming	Making a video clip a specific length by cutting off any unneeded parts
