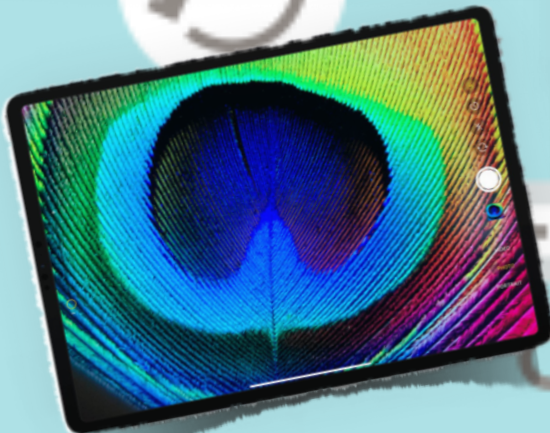

Key vocabulary

Photo	A photograph is an image, or picture, that has been captured on film or some other material.
Camera	An instrument used to take, or record, pictures of people and objects.
Photo Editing	To change an image.
Crop	To remove parts of a digital image.
Rotate	To change the angle of an image.
Filters	Tools that can enhance or alter the appearance of your photos.
Mark-up	A tool that allows you to draw and sketch in your documents.
Delete	To remove something.
