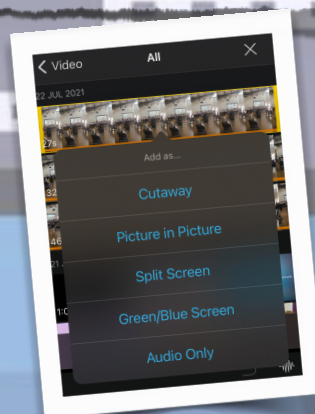


Key vocabulary

Titles	Text you can add to a movie
Trimming	Making a video clip a specific length by cutting off any parts not needed.
Voiceover	Speech audio that is played over the top of the video clip
Detach audio	Removing the audio from a video clip
Transition	How two video clips merge together when one ends and one starts
Split	To cut a video clip into two separate parts and create two separate clips

Key learning

- Insert different videos, trim them, split them and detach audio
- Change the speed and volume of a video clip
- Add text using a range of title styles
- Use sound effects and background music at specific points
- Add a voiceover
- Include pictures and adjust their movements
- Use transitions between video clips



Video editing – Our Learning Journey

Year 2
