Shabbat: means to stop.

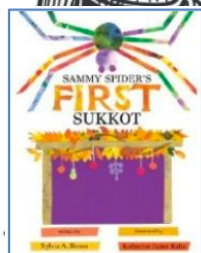
Synagogue: the special building for Jewish people to worship God
