Creation Vocabulary	
Omniscient	All-knowing. Christians believe God knows everything: the past, the present and the future.
Omnipotent	All-powerful. Christians believe God has unlimited power and can do anything that is possible.
Worship	Showing love, respect and devotion to God.
Guidance	Help or advice that shows someone the right way to live or what decision to make.

**Prior Knowledge:**

- They are called to sacrifice things to follow Jesus and for some this might mean to die (such as members of the early church)
- That Jesus offers a way to heal the damage done by human sin.
- The Christian Church is part of the ongoing story of the People of God.
- They should try to live in a way that attracts others to God
- Know some Muslims believe that
- Muslims are expected to pray 5 times a day
- Muslims observe their own prayer rituals which include cleansing and positions
- Prayer positions symbolise equality for all Muslims
- Some Muslims believe that it is important to cover their heads to show respect and commitment to their faith as adults

Some Muslims believe that dressing modestly helps bring them closer to Allah.

**Key Knowledge:**

Christians believe God is omnipotent – this means He is all-powerful.  
 Christians believe God is omniscient – this means He knows everything.  
 God is eternal – He has always existed and will exist forever.  
 God is worthy of worship – Christians show love and respect to God through prayer, singing, reading the Bible and going to church.

Christians learn about God through the Bible, but some people may interpret the texts in different ways.

Christians try to follow God's example, especially through the teachings and actions of Jesus.

Humanists do not worship a god.

Humanists celebrate human achievements, values and experiences.

Humanist gatherings focus on ideas like human rights, science and community.

**Generalisation:**

God is omnipotent, eternal and worthy of worship. Believers seek guidance by turning to God because they trust him to be wise and comforting. Humanists seek guidance and follow role models but not God.
