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**Statutory Assessment Results 2025-26**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are absolutely delighted to share the outstanding results from this year's statutory assessments. These achievements are not only a reflection of academic success but also a powerful demonstration of the values that lie at the heart of St. Peter's: **Respect, Wisdom, Aspiration, and Community**.

Our pupils have risen to every challenge with resilience and commitment. Their progress and outcomes are truly exceptional:

Year group	Headlines
<b>Key Stage 2 (Year 6):</b>	<p><b>85%</b> of pupils met the expected standard in <b>Reading, Writing and Maths combined</b> – significantly above the national average of 62%, placing us in the <b>96th percentile nationally</b>.</p> <p><b>18%</b> achieved the <b>higher standard</b>, well above the national figure of 8%</p> <p>Outstanding subject results include <b>88%</b> meeting expectations in Maths, <b>90%</b> in Writing, and <b>85%</b> in Reading.</p> <p><b>90%</b> of pupils reached the expected standard in Grammar Punctuation and Spelling, with an impressive <b>55%</b> achieving the higher standard.</p>
<b>Multiplication Tables Check (Year 4):</b>	<p><b>53%</b> of pupils achieved <b>full marks (25/25)</b>, well above the estimated national figure of 38%.</p> <p><b>85%</b> of pupils achieved a score of at least 21 and above which is considered a pass.</p>
<b>Phonics Screening Check (Year 1):</b>	<p>An incredible <b>96%</b> of pupils passed – FAR above the national average and placing us in the top 6% of schools.</p>
<b>Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS):</b>	<p><b>76%</b> of pupils achieved a Good Level of Development, ahead of national trends.</p>

These results are a proud moment for us all. They reflect our children's **aspiration** to be their best, the **wisdom** they've gained through rich learning experiences, the **respect** they show daily in their learning
