


















# History Concepts

 <p><b><u>Chronology:</u></b></p> <p>The order in which key events happened or important historical figures lived and how these events connect or overlap.</p>	 <p><b><u>Historical enquiry:</u></b></p> <p>The range of sources that provide information about history and their reliability or accuracy</p>	 <p><b><u>Significance:</u></b></p> <p>Anything that has a bearing on a person or an event and how this influenced a situation – including how the past is remembered.</p>	
 <p><b><u>Similarity and difference:</u></b></p> <p>Comparing people, places and events by looking at their similarities and differences.</p>	 <p><b><u>Change and continuity:</u></b></p> <p>Over time, some things stay the same and some change both across and within different time periods. This can influence how we live today.</p>	 <p><b><u>Cause and consequence</u></b></p> <p>The reason for and impact of events in history on civilisations and the wider world both at the time and in the future.</p>	 <p><b><u>Interpretations</u></b></p> <p>The way in which events in the past are explained – the difference between fact and opinion</p>

 <p><b><u>Diversity:</u></b></p> <p>How history has shaped the modern world in terms of faith, culture and gender equality.</p>	 <p><b><u>Ethics:</u></b></p> <p>Understand moral principles – right or wrong?</p>	 <p><b><u>Legacy:</u></b></p> <p>Something that is handed down from one period of time to another period of time.</p>	 <p><b><u>Society:</u></b></p> <p>People living together in an ordered community.</p>	 <p><b><u>Invasion:</u></b></p> <p>To enter without permission or with force.</p>
 <p><b><u>Rebellion:</u></b></p> <p>People fight against their leader or government.</p>	 <p><b><u>Monarchy:</u></b></p> <p>A country with a king or queen in charge</p>	 <p><b><u>Empire:</u></b></p> <p>When different people or countries are ruled by one person or country</p>	 <p><b><u>Democracy:</u></b></p> <p>A country that is run by its people.</p>	 <p><b><u>Trade:</u></b></p> <p>The action of buying and selling goods and services.</p>
